Public Comment Guidelines

Any person shall be permitted to address a meeting of The Township Board, which is required to be open to the public under the provision of the Michigan Open Meetings Act, as amended (MCL 15.261 et. seq.). Public Comment shall be carried out in accordance with the following Board Rules and Procedures: a) any person wishing to address the Board is requested (though not required) to state their name and address. b) No person shall be allowed to speak more than once on the same matter. Where constrained by available time the Chairperson may limit the amount of time each person will be allowed to speak to (2) minutes. 1). The Chairperson may at his or her own discretion, extend the amount of time any person is allowed to speak. 2) Whenever a Group wishes to address a Committee, the Chairperson may request that the Group designate a spokesperson; the Chairperson shall control the amount of tie the spokesperson shall be allowed to speak when constrained by available time.
